Dear Montbello Families:

I'm extremely proud to serve as your new principal of Montbello Middle School and I'm looking forward to connecting soon with you and your student(s) as we kick off a great school year. Please excuse the length of this communication, but I wanted to take a moment to provide some information and answer some of the questions you all may have as we prepare to welcome our students back.

Registration: As was communicated, registration is taking place this week, on August 10th and August 11th. To expedite the registration process, we will require that you bring a current copy of your student's immunization record from a doctor's office. Additionally, if you have recently moved, please provide a proof of address (this can be a utility bill or lease agreement). Montbello's in person registration will take place at the following times: :

Thursday, August 10: 12:00 pm to 7:00 pm

Friday, August 11: 8:00 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm

School Calendar: Montbello Middle School follows the <u>Denver Public Schools Calendar</u>. The exception is our staggered grade level start dates.

First days: The first day for **6th grade students is Monday, August 21.** We'll begin school at 9:00 am and end at 4:20pm This time will be used for a 6th grade orientation, where students will engage in community building activities, learn to operate their lockers, and become familiar with the building.

The first day for 7th grade and 8th grade is Tuesday, August 22nd.

School Start/End Times: As DPS is moving forward with our "Healthy Start Times" Initiative, our school day will begin later than last year. This year Montbello's school day will be from 9:00 am to 4:20 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Wednesday will still be an early release day, with classes dismissing at 1:30 pm.

Bussing: Because Montbello Middle School students receive FNE (Far Northeast) Shuttle Services, we want to make sure you have the correct information about which bus your students should use. Please use this link to locate the most appropriate shuttle your student should take.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I pay for school fees online?

Fees may be paid for through www.MySchoolBucks.com. In early August, Ms. Gutierrez-Mota, our school financial secretary, will invoice your student for school fees. This should generate an email notification to you with a link and directions for how to access MySchoolBucks and pay for those fees. Please know that beginning this school year DPS will now utilize the "Healthy Meals for All" program, providing free lunch for every student. Although lunch is free for all students this year, we do need all families to complete the "You Benefit" application on the "My School App" website. Lastly, "MySchoolBucks" will not be used to pay for school meals.

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When does school start this year?

August 21, 9:00 am - 4:20 pm for **6th graders**

August 22, 9:00 am - 4:20 pm for **7th graders and 8th graders** (6th still comes)

August 23, 9:00 am - 1:30 pm for ALL STUDENTS COME, but it's an early release

Why do 6th grade students have a different start date?

Middle school can be a little intimidating for 6th grade students. Having a special day for 6th graders gives them an opportunity to orient themselves to school prior to starting classes.

What are the school office hours?

The office hours are 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. If you need to reach someone before or after hours, please leave a voicemail in the main office and the appropriate person will receive the message the next morning.

Do I need to purchase school supplies?

When is Back-to-School Night at Montbello?

It is Thursday, September 13th from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm. This is an opportunity to hear from school leadership, visit your child's classrooms, and hear about new and ongoing programs at Montbello.

When will my child receive his/her schedule?

Your child's schedule will be provided to them during the first day of school (**August 21st for 6th graders**, **and August 22nd for 7th and 8th graders**). Any schedule changes will not take place immediately, however, after we have settled into the school year, we will examine any potential schedule issues and work collaboratively to come up with the best possible outcome for your student's learning.

What is Montbello's cell phone policy?

As our primary focus is your child's education, we are asking our families to support our cell phone policy for the 2023-24 school year. Students cannot carry a phone anywhere in the school building during school hours. Cell phones are to be locked in student lockers or left at home. If parents need to reach their child, they call the main office, and we'll bring the student to the office. This policy has been effective in lowering online bullying incidents, and promoting more social skills among our middle schoolers. As we work to move our students toward academic excellence it is imperative to remove any barriers to their learning.

What kind of sports are offered at Montbello?

While we aim to have the typical seasonal sports offered by other DPS schools, sports at Montbello are dependent on student interest and coach availability. How do I notify the school if my child is absent?
